

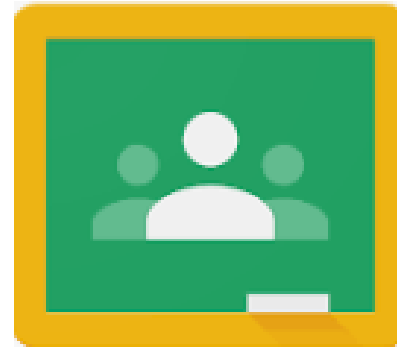
# Google Classroom

Class code

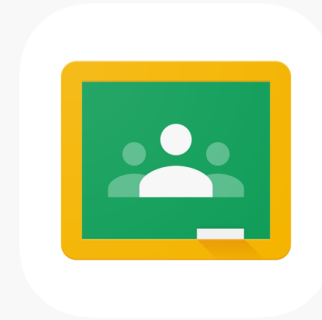
Ask your teacher for the class code, then enter it here.

To sign in with a class code

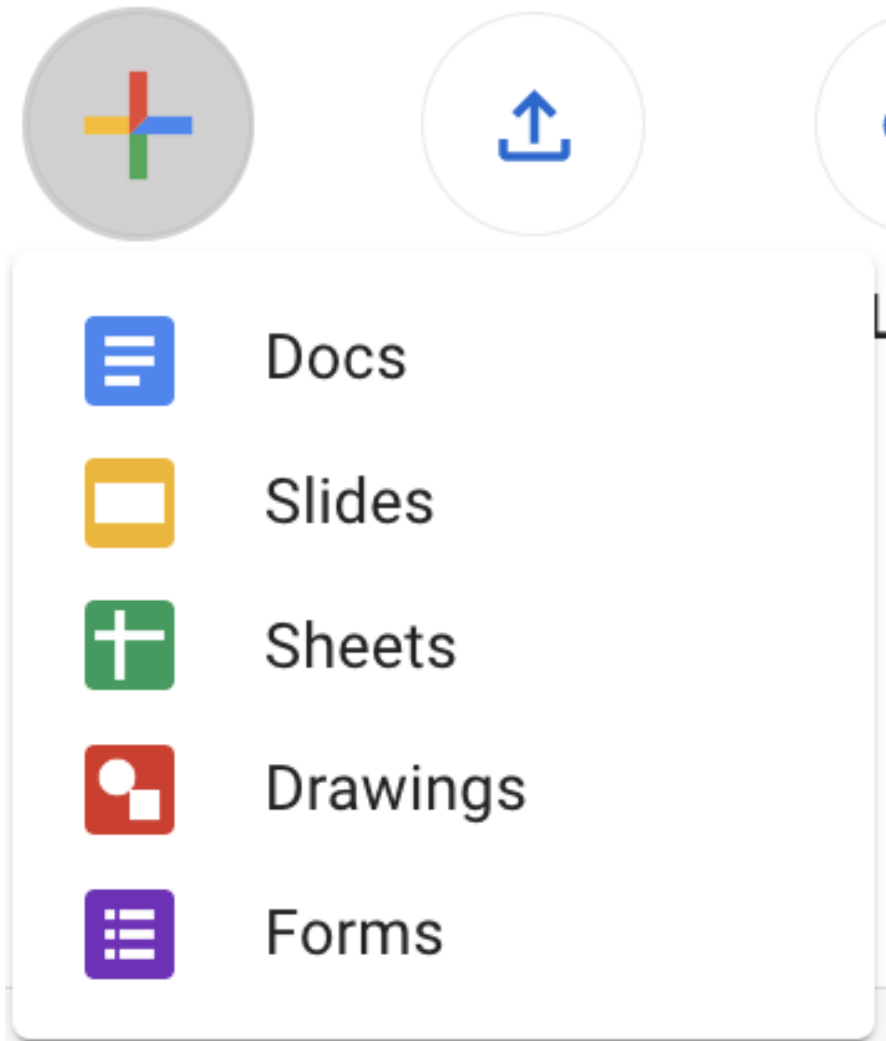
- Use an authorised account
